100 Years

February 3, 2026, marks the 100 year anniversary of the inception of the Order of the Sons of Pericles, the Junior Auxiliary of the Order of AHEPA. Since our founding in Manchester, New Hampshire, almost a century ago, the members of our organization have made a profound impact not just in their home communities, but out in the world as well. Leadership skills learned in the Sons of Pericles have been taken into the business world and our current, former, and lifetime members continue to thrive. It is our hope that no matter where you are in life currently or what your connection to the Sons of Pericles may be, that you will support us in our endeavor to honor one hundred years of our organizations commitment to our shared Heritage, our love of Service, and our Brotherhood.



About Us

The Sons of Pericles are an international brotherhood dedicated to the preservation of Hellenism. In addition, the Order espouses philanthropy, civic responsibility, athletics, education and individual excellence.

In 1922, the Order of AHEPA was founded in Atlanta, GA. The South in those days, as most of us know, was not a society of equals. Along with African-Americans, Catholics, Jews and Greeks were increasingly becoming the targets of the Ku Klux Klan. After the hanging of a young Greek-American by the Klan, a group of Greek-American men in Atlanta formed the Order of AHEPA. Consequently, AHEPA's original cause was to fight racism and to assist Greeks from Greece to immigrate and assimilate into the North American mainstream. The AHEPA membership was made up of adult Greek males.

In the years that followed, eleven young Greek males, with a spirit that equaled that of their ancestors, conceived the idea of and organized the Sons of Pericles. The purpose was to compliment the AHEPA and serve as a vehicle to keep the young Greeks, living in North America, together so they would never lose touch with the Greek culture. The Sons of Pericles were started in 1926 by a group of Manchester, N.H. AHEPANS. The founder was Dr. Alexander Cambadhis. He helped the fledging new youth group with their dealings with other organizations as well as with the Order of AHEPA. His goal and the goal of the Sons of Pericles is to promote Hellenism to the youth and to keep the fire of our Motherland burning for generations to come. Together with the aid of some members of the Order of AHEPA from the Manchester, NH Chapter, these young men were the first members of the Order and are known collectively as The Mother Lodge of the Sons of Pericles.

The first chapter named itself the Queen City Chapter #1. Its first officers were installed on February 3, 1926. Within a year, the first National Convention was held in Lowell, MA with 14 Chapters in the fraternity. In 1928, in Detroit, MI, the Sons were officially recognized as the Junior Order of AHEPA. In 1932 at the National Convention in Akron, OH, the Order expanded its jurisdiction into Montreal, Canada, thereby making it the first international Greek Youth Organization in the world.

Our Mission

Like our Brothers in the Order of AHEPA, The Sons of Pericles strive to promote the ancient Hellenic ideals of education, philanthropy, civic responsibility, family and individual excellence through community service and volunteerism. The Sons of Pericles have adopted the motto "Heritage, Service, Brotherhood" to define our specific and significant impact.

Our Achievements

One of the biggest aspects of our Order is our commitment to our philanthropic endeavors. Not only do the Sons of Pericles strive to preserve our rich Hellenic heritage, but we want to leave a mark on this world and do our very best to make a difference.

In 1932, with the activation of our Montreal, Quebec chapter, the Sons of Pericles became the first International Greek Youth Organization in the World.

In 1938, the Sons of Pericles sponsored its own Excursion to Greece and decided to dedicate a monument at Missolonghi to commemorate the historic struggle that took place there during the Greek Revolution. The project was endorsed by the U.S. Congress and dedicated July 4, 1939.

Though the Sons of Pericles took a hiatus during WWII, those members who were not serving the country overseas helped the Order of AHEPA sell more war bonds than any other organization.

The Sons have worked with their sister organization, the Maids of Athena, to co-host Salute to Youth banquets where they have honored the likes of Senator Paul Sarbanes and Sargent Shriver (1984), Broadcast Journalist Ike Pappas (1986), Congressman George Gekas (1988), and Christos Cotsakos, Chairman & CEO of E*Trade (2001).

Each year, the Sons of Pericles select a project to support collectively on an international level. Each individual Sons of Pericles Chapter is encouraged to participate in this effort, and over the past century the Sons of Pericles have proudly contributed over a million dollars to many worthwhile charitable organizations.

We have consistently promoted education and have recently reinstated our National Scholarship Program, which provides scholarship opportunities to members of the Sons of Pericles in good standing.

The Sons of Pericles host successful national and regional athletic and social events, bringing together our members from all over the globe in a celebration of our shared heritage. Often, these weekends are accompanied by participation in a service project so our members can give something back to the community and again, show that the Sons of Pericles can make a difference.

All of these accomplishments are notable, yes, but they are only a few. Our greatest achievement is maintaining the integrity of this organization for 100 years, and that's something that deserves to be honored.
